STUDENT UNIFORMS

POLICY:

To ensure high standards and uniformity of dress and appearance in school, Escuela Caribe and New Horizons Academy recommend school uniforms be purchased through a J.C. Penney uniform catalog (or equivalent).

PROCEDURES:

- I. Escuela Caribe (CVS) and NHA recommend the following items to be ordered from J.C. Penney so as to ensure high standards and uniformity of dress and appearance in school.
- II. Girls School Uniform:
 - a. 5 Blouses (white or light blue)
 - b. 4 pairs Navy blue dress slacks (Docker's style) or skirts (may be Navy blue or green and blue plaid) or any combination. **Skirt length must be below the knee.**
 - c. 2 Navy blue or white cardigans or pullovers (or any combination thereof)
- III. Boys School Uniform:
 - a. 5 Oxford shirts (white or light blue)
 - b. 4 pairs Navy blue dress slacks (Docker's style)
 - c. 2 Navy blue or white cardigans or pullovers (or any combination thereof)

All parent visits and phone call scheduling will be done by mail, e-mail, or by your enrolled child himself/herself, providing that he/she meets the level requirements. For students at the end of their stay or those in the re-entry stage, parental contact is a therapeutic issue. Sometimes the student may choose not to communicate. Please be patient. We will work on this issue with your child.
